Researchers agree that reading, talking, and singing to children is the single most important thing a parent can do to prepare their child for school and life-long success.

#### THE ISSUE

Early childhood, especially infancy, offers a critical window for learning with rapid brain development that doesn't occur at any other time. Reading aloud, talking to, and singing to babies stimulate language development long before a child can talk. Studies are now showing that this stimulation even occurs in the womb! Preparation for learning starts at birth, yet less than half of parents in our region have daily habits of reading, talking, or singing to their young children.

> ONLY 15% READ TO THEIR INFANTS and TODDLERS.

Born to Read has created a 5-point strategy for engaging families with young children and encouraging them to read to their babies, every day, right from the start:

- **l.** Introduce the Born to Read message to expectant parents at Munson Medical Center.
- 2. Deliver Welcome Baby kits with a book and information to new parents at Munson Medical Center.
- **3.** Link new parents to local libraries where they receive a gift bag with another free book for their baby and are encouraged to participate in story times and other activities.
- **4.** Provide early literacy training to BTR Ambassadors, volunteers, child care staff, and outreach workers to help spread the message about the importance of reading, talking, and singing to babies.
- 5. Provide trained Ambassadors at community sites where low-income parents and young children gather to model reading aloud to children and share the Born to Read message with parents.

# BORN TO READ **AMBASSADORS**

Born to Read Ambassadors go where parents and young children are - food pantries, laundry projects, play groups and other community sites. Volunteers read to kids and talk to parents about how important it is to read, talk, and sing to their young children everyday right from the start. They also give each child a book to take home.
